Accessing E-books



Visit the e-iNC website at: https://e-inc.overdrive.com/

- Click 'Sign-in' at the top right on e-iNC Library homepage.
- Select your library and enter your Duplin County Library card # and PIN # and click Sign In.
- You can search by using the 'Search' box at the top right or by collection or genre as listed across the top of the screen.
- Hover over the book you are interested in for option: Borrow, Sample, Add to Wish List, Share, or More.
- If the book is currently checked out, instead of 'Borrow' you will see 'Place Hold'. Click on this to put your name on the request list. You will be contacted by mail when the book is ready for you.
- If you wish to borrow the book, click on 'Borrow'. You will get a message to 'Go to checkouts'.
- From 'checkouts' screen, you may choose 'Read' in your browser or download to your device.
- You may have up to 4 titles out at a time and 4 holds. Loan period is 2 weeks.
- Books are never overdue. They will return automatically.
- You will receive an email notification when your loan is about to expire and another email once it has expired.
- Books that you choose to 'Read' in your browser can be read offline. Once the book is open, click on Menu icon and select 'Offline Access'. Click on the cloud to download all pages for offline reading. Save as a bookmark for easy access.
