Can't I just burn my garbage?

North Carolina law allows the burning of vegetative debri only. It is illegal to burn anything else. Duplin County Sheriff's office employs an Enforcement Officer to investigate and prosecute burning complaints, illegal dumping and littering violations. State law and Duplin County's Waste Management Ordinance provides for the prosecution of those who burn, dump trash on other's property or public highways with stiff financial penalties.

Duplin County operates 15 collection sites to receive garbage and recyclables from it's rural residences. Operating cost are financed through annual availability fees and there is no additional cost for items delivered to the collection centers. Attendants are on duty to insure proper placement of materials.

Got tires?

Tires are accepted free of charge at the **Duplin County Solid Waste Landfill** at 325 Landfill Road, Rose Hill.

NC State Cover Law requires all vehicles driven on any highway must be loaded to prevent trash from falling, blowing, dropping or escaping. Loads should be secured by tarps, straps or any other means to prevent littering.









Unacceptable Materials - Must go to Landfill **Appliances with Freon - Any appliance** with freon such as refrigerator, freezer, air conditioners..... NO CHARGE. Unacceptable Materials - Must go to Landfill Yard Debri - Leaves, limbs, stumps, any

vegetative debri. SMALL CHARGE. nacceptable Materials - Must go to Landfill Construction - Flooring, carpet, lumber, tile, any material from remodeling, repair jobs, tearing down. SMALL CHARGE. No Contractors or Businesses allowed.
