## Literary Arts Information

**Limit:** Only ONE entry is allowed in each sub category.

**Details:** An original and two copies of the entry and the SilverArts Information Form must be enclosed with Registration. Online registrations require a PDF attachment. Entries may also be sent virtually to the Local Coordinator at [akendall@cravencountync.gov](mailto:akendall@cravencountync.gov).

- Poems can be no longer than 40 lines.
- Short stories (fiction), essays (not autobiographical), articles, life experiences can be no longer than 8 pages double-spaced with a 1" margin on all sides. Entries must have a title page which includes the title of the work, sub-category, and artist name.

**Awards:** 1st or 2nd place in the sub-category in a Local Games qualify. Winners will be announced through social media as well as the Craven County Recreation and Parks website on Friday, April 29. Medals will then be mailed to winners or available for pick up at the Craven County Recreation office.

All entries must be received by **Wednesday, April 27**.

## General Submission Guidelines

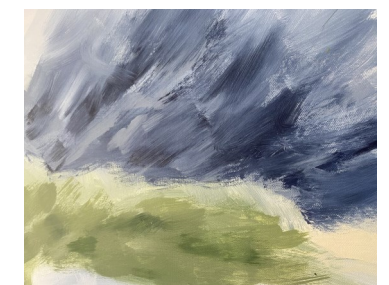
- Take photos in a well-lit area
- Take photos against a black, white, or otherwise neutral background
- "Front" photo should always include the **WHOLE** piece in the photo, and be as straight on as possible
- If your piece is framed, include the whole frame in the "front" photo of your piece
- If your piece is framed behind glass, try to reduce glare and reflection on the glass
- 3D entries: All Heritage Art categories, and Visual Art categories Mixed Media, and Sculpture can submit up to six (6) photos (including a front photo, a birds-eye-view photo, detail photo, bottom and photos of all sides if applicable)
- 2D entries: All Visual Art categories EXCEPT Mixed Media and Sculpture can submit up to three (3) photos (3 photos are recommended, including a front photo, side photo, and detail photo)

## Silver Arts Competition

At present, Silver Arts recognizes four broad categories, each with several sub-categories. First and second place winners in the Literary subcategory will be eligible for the NC Senior Games Finals. First, second and third place winners in the Visual and Heritage sub-categories will be eligible for the NC Senior Games Finals. North Carolina Senior Games Finals awards, first, second and third place in each sub-category of these arts.

One overall winner in the Performing Arts category will also be eligible for the North Carolina Senior Games Finals and able to compete for first, second and third place awards. **The Neuse River Senior Games awards first, second, and third place in all the sub-categories.**

### Guidelines

- All persons entering Silver Arts must be 50 years of age or better and registered as a Neuse River Senior Games participant.
- Entries must be original works of the artist; must be a work created after the artist is age 50 or better and have been completed within two years of the Neuse River Senior Games registration deadline.

The Neuse River Senior Games and the North Carolina Senior Games State Finals have the right to refuse or remove any or all entries that are deemed obnoxious or repulsive in character.

## Heritage & Visual Arts Information

**Limit:** Only ONE entry is allowed in each sub category. Grouped sets may have NO MORE THAN three items in that set.

**Details:** The Heritage and Visual Arts competition will be judged by photos of the entries. Silver Artists will register via Torch 1.0 or paper registration via the registration packet. Additional entry photos may also be submitted via email to [akendall@cravencountync.gov](mailto:akendall@cravencountync.gov). For online registration in Torch 1.0, one photo is required when registering. For paper registrations, photos should be included with registration. One photo of each entry will be included in the online Silver Arts Showcase Gallery.

- Art work, except sculptures, can be no larger than 36" x 42", including matting and frame.
- Master studies are accepted.
- The art piece must be an original work, not print, and the artist's name and title of entry must appear on or be attached to the entry for identification.
- The artist must send a photograph of the entry with the State Finals Entry Form and Silver Arts Information Form when entering the State Finals.
- Heritage art entries must be original work and the work of the individual and not a group effort.

**Awards:** 1st, 2nd or 3rd place in a sub-category will qualify for State Finals. Winners will be announced through social media as well as the Craven County Recreation and Parks website on Friday, April 29. Medals will then be mailed to winners or available for pick up at the Craven County Recreation and Parks office.

### Registration Fees

A registration fee of \$12.00 is required from all participants registering by **Friday, March 18**. Some activities will require extra fees (*this is indicated on the registration form*), which should be submitted in addition to the registration fee. **All fees must accompany the registration/waiver form for the participant to be eligible.** The registration fee includes a Neuse River Senior Games T-shirt.

A limited number of Registration Fee Waivers are available. A waiver is the base \$12.00 fee. To request and be considered for a waiver, please check the line on the first page of the Registration Form.

*Due to the strenuous nature of the athletic events, it is recommended that you consult your physician prior to beginning training for the actual competition.*

A participant must be a North Carolina resident for a minimum of 3 consecutive months of the year.

Only persons who are 50 years of age by December 31, 2022 or better and residents of the six sponsoring counties (**Craven, Duplin, Greene, Jones, Lenoir, and Pamlico**) are eligible to participate in the Neuse River Senior Games.

## General Information

Participants must complete the official registration form with signature, inclusive of medical information and physicians phone number. The liability waiver must be signed and the "fees" section of the registration form must be completed.

**Confirmation:** In early April, you will receive a letter confirming your events with times and places listed. If you believe the confirmation is incorrect, please call (252) 636-6606 to verify.

**Rules:** Rules for all events are available at [www.ncseniorgames.org](http://www.ncseniorgames.org) or by contacting Craven County Recreation & Parks, 252-636-6606.

**Athletic Awards:** In Athletic Events, Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals will be awarded to the top three finishers in each age category, for males and females. Awards will be available to winners and distributed following the conclusion of each event or at the Craven County Recreation and Parks offices at 1821 Old Airport Road, New Bern, NC.

**Silver Arts Awards:** First, second & third place winners in **Visual and Heritage Arts** will be eligible for the NC Senior Games Finals. First & second place winners in the **Literary sub-category** will be eligible for the NC Senior Games Finals. However, North Carolina Senior Games Finals awards first, second, and third place in each sub-category of these arts.

## Athletic Events

**State Finals Entry Forms:** DO NOT MAIL BEFORE MAY 31, 2022! The State Finals entry form must be received in Raleigh at the NC Senior Games Office no later than 11:59 p.m. on August 1, 2022.

Please indicate the events you wish to enter on the registration form. You may enter all the events you wish, but if two events overlap or are scheduled at the same time, it is up to you to meet the games requirements for those events.

**Tournament** events require you to report at the time listed. Tournament events are indicated with an asterisk (\*). **Open** events allow you to report at any time during the time period listed.

Where a time conflict exists between tournament and open events, you must report to the tournament event first and participate *prior* to moving on to the open event. **Failure to do so will cause disqualification.**

Your age as of December 31, 2022 determines the category in which you will be placed for competition. Participants compete against others of their own sex and age as follows:

50-54   55-59   60-64   65-69   70-74   75-79   80-84   85-89   90-94   95-99   100+
