### Can't I just burn my garbage?

North Carolina law allows the burning of vegetative debris only. It is illegal to burn anything else. Duplin County Solid Waste employs an Enforcement Officer to investigate and prosecute burning complaints, illegal dumping and littering violations. State laws and Duplin County's Waste Management Ordinance provides for the prosecution of those who burn, dump trash on other's property or public highways with stiff financial penalties.

Duplin County operates 15 collection sites to receive garbage and recyclables from its rural residences. Operating cost are financed through annual availability fees and there is no additional cost for items delivered to the collection centers. Attendants are on duty to insure proper placement of materials.

Tires are accepted free of charge at the Duplin County Solid Waste Landfill at 325 Landfill Road, Rose Hill.

### COVER THAT LOAD!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

NC State Cover Law requires all vehicles driven on any highway must be loaded to prevent trash from falling, blowing, dropping or escaping. Loads should be secured by tarps, straps or any other means to prevent littering.

**NO compressed tanks of any kind - LP gas or air / H2O / Helium / Propane**



**Paint Cans - Can be accepted ONLY if they are empty or have been filled with something to absorb the paint.**
















### Unacceptable Materials - Must go to Landfill

**Yard Debris - Leaves, limbs, stumps, any vegetative debris. SMALL CHARGE.**  
**Unacceptable Materials - Must go to Landfill**  
**Construction - Flooring, carpet, lumber, tile, any material from remodeling, repair jobs, tearing down. SMALL CHARGE.**

## What Can I Recycle?



Materials Accepted	What to Recycle	How To Recycle	What Not to Include
<b>Cardboard</b> 	Brown Corrugated Cardboard boxes.	Empty, break down, and flatten the boxes. Place in cardboard container.	NO waxed produce or packing materials. NO pizza boxes.
<b>News and Mixed Paper</b> 	Clean, dry newspapers, mixed paper such as magazines, catalogs, mail, cereal boxes, office and school papers and colored cardboard.	Place untied and unbagged news and mixed papers in the mixed paper container.	NO newspaper used to drain foods or to train animals. NO plastic bags and NO pizza or food boxes.
<b>Beverage Cans</b> 	Aluminum beer and soft drink cans.	Empty cans and place in beverage can bin.	NO aluminum foil or pie plates.
<b>Food Cans</b> 	Steel (tin) cans used for fruit, vegetables, soups, juices and other food items.	Rinse cans. Place in food can containers. No need to remove labels.	NO aerosol cans such as hairspray, shaving cream, spray paint or cleanser cans.
<b>#1 and #2 Plastic Containers</b> 	Plastic soda bottles, milk jugs, detergent containers, shampoo or conditioner bottles, etc. 	Remove the lids, rinse and flatten. Check to bottom of the container for symbol and sort by code. 	NO tubs, pots, oil bottles or plastic grocery bags. NO pesticide jugs.
<b>Glass Bottles and Jars</b> 	Clear, brown and green glass bottles and jars.	Remove lids and rinse. Sort by color.	NO window panes., coffee cups, ceramics, mirrors, windshield glass, Pyrex dishes or light bulbs.
<b>Motor Oil - Oil Filters</b> 	Motor oil from cars, trucks and other vehicles and equipment. Oil filters accepted at site 2-4-6-8-11-12.	Pour discarded oil into collection drum and filters into oil filter bin. Oil filter bins are at sites 2-3-4-12-13.	NO oil mixed with water, antifreeze, gasoline or other solvents.
<b>Pesticide Containers</b> 	Pesticide Containers. Sites 2-3-4-12-13.	Triple rinse or pressure rinse pesticide containers.	Remove instruction booklets.
<b>Lead Acid Batteries</b> 	Car, truck, marine, mower, heavy equipment batteries.	See attendant for designated area.	NO household (alkaline) batteries & NO Nicad batteries.
<b>Scrap Metal</b> 	Major appliances such as dishwashers, washers, dryers and other scrap metals can be placed in the metal recycling bin at the collection center. For easier unloading, please take large loads to the Duplin County Solid Waste Department in Rose Hill. <b>There is no charge for scrap metal.</b>		
<b>Electronics</b> 	TVs, computers, printers, radios, monitors, stereos, fax machines, VCRs and DVDs.	Place in electronic containers at collection sites 3 - 6 - 8 - 10 - 12 - 13 - 15 and main landfill. <b>There is no charge for electronics.</b>
